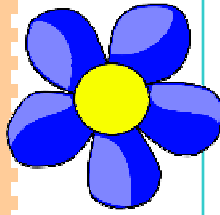

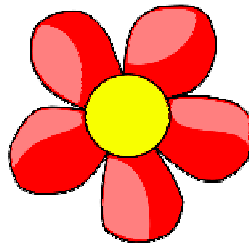
Easter Egg Hunt
